Reverend Dr. Rameen M. Jackson Pastoral Biography

The Reverend Dr. Rameen M. Jackson is an anointed, uniquely gifted and powerful preacher and teacher of God's word. He is a leader that is dedicated to the work of Christ Jesus. He was born on the East End of Long Island, New York, where he also raised his family. He attended the Riverhead Schools and graduated with his Regents Diploma. Dr. Jackson furthered his education by attending the State University of New York Old Westbury College in Westbury, New York and completed his B.A. Degree in Industrial Labor and Relations. After accepting his call into ministry, he decided to further his theological studies at New Brunswick Theological Seminary in New Brunswick, New Jersey completing a Master of Divinity degree. He obtained his Doctor of Ministry Degree from Virginia Union University's Samuel Dewitt Proctor School of Theology in Richmond, Virginia in May of 2017.



On Sunday September 25, 2011 Dr. Jackson was installed as pastor of the First Baptist Church of Logan Park, located in Norfolk, Virginia.

Dr. Jackson has preached youth services, revivals, men's conferences and facilitated workshops all over the New York and Virginia area, as well as other states. His key verse is, Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ that strengthens me".

Reverend Dr. Cameron J. Greer Pastoral Biography

The Reverend Dr. Cameron Jerrod Greer is a preacher, educator, and life coach. A proud native of Dallas, Texas. He received his spiritual formation at St. Luke “Community” United Methodist Church. He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in English from Huston-Tillotson University in Austin, Texas.



He received a Master of Divinity and Doctor of Ministry from Perkins School of Theology at Southern Methodist University in Dallas. His dissertation reflects his commitment to faith-based community engagement and urban education: “Keeping it Real in Urban Ministry: The Black Church in the age of #BlackLivesMatter.”

He received his ministerial ordination within the Baptist church. He is a certified life coach. He currently teaches English at Young Men's Leadership Academy in the Fort Worth Independent School District.

Dr. Greer is a community organizer and activist. In 2013, Dr. Greer started the Cameron Jerrod Greer Foundation designed to engage and empower young people to transform their world by igniting impact through literacy and writing. His life mission is to grow and develop God’s people through the life-changing, uncompromising Word of God.

Rev. Dr. Michael G. Sykes Pastoral Biography

The Rev. Dr. Michael G. Sykes is presently serving as the Senior Minister of Faith United Protestant Church in Park Forest, Illinois where he was appointed in 2008. Prior to being called to his present positions, Rev. Sykes was Associate Pastor at Trinity United Church of Christ in Chicago from August of 2000 to January of 2008. Rev. Sykes also served as the head of Pastoral Care at Michael Reese Hospital in Chicago for 13 years.



Dr. Sykes received his formal education at Bradley University and the University of Illinois at Chicago. He later received his seminary training at the Chicago Theological Seminary in Hyde Park, where he received his *Master of Divinity* degree in June of 1999 and his *Doctor of Ministry* degree in 2015.

Before entering the ministry, Rev. Sykes was employed in the field of corporate marketing, serving as a Marketing Manager with Time Warner in Chicago and later as an Assistant Vice-President with Citibank in Baltimore, Maryland.
